JPS STRENGTHS

With New Science laboratories, the application of theories has enhanced and with installation of Fire equipment and CCTV cameras at different strategic places, safety measures are put in place.

NEW EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM

We follow the NEP i.e. National Education Policy and NCF National Curriculum Framework pattern with NCERT curriculum to enhance the capabilities of our students. This includes Foundational Stage: (Grade 1& 2); Preparation Stage: (Grades 3 to 5) and Middle Stage (Grades 6 to 8).

ELGA curriculum is taught to grades 1 to 5 to enhance the English language.

Every Saturday Special Scholarship classes for the Students of Grades 5 & 8 are held And also Extra classes and Remedial classes for all the other students of different grades to bridge the learning gap caused by the COVID-19.

OPPORTUNITIES PROVIDED:

New academic subjects:

- Besides Languages, Math, Science or EVS, IT and SST, Health & Physical Education, Library period, Art education as well as General Knowledge and Value Education are added to enhance the personality of the students.

Daily assembly:

- An empowering platform is provided to enhance literary skills, build confidence and improve one’s personality to all the students from Grade 1 to Grade 8. It is done Class wise and House wise. On Saturdays Student Council members animate the assembly.

Sports:

- Apart from imparting excellent academics facilities facilitated by the trained teachers, the school also caters to bring excellence in sports. Our students are given coaching in Kabbadi, Kho Kho, Cricket and Taekwando.

Festivals

- School is considered as a miniature society and so all the national, state, school and religious festivals are celebrated with equal fervour.

- Cultural Activities like- Dahi Handi, Ganesh Feast, Eid, Diwali and Christmas celebrations are instrumental in building inclusive education in the School.
- Teacher's day, Yoga day, Children's day, Independence Day, Constitution Day Republic Day, were celebrated to ignite the spirit of nationalism and patriotism.

Picnic

- Our students, enjoyed a day of Picnic at Anthurium Resort, Wagholi. It was a day of relaxation, nature trails, and games.

Competitions

- School also conducts various Inter- house competitions like Singing, Handwriting, Drawing, One act plays, Elocution, Abhang & Poetry recitation etc. to help students nurture their talents.

Competitive Exams

- To develop Confidence & competitive spirit various exams like SOF Olympiads in English, Science, History, Computers, General Knowledge are held.
- State Scholarship exams for all the students of grades 5 and 8 are given equal importance.

Orientations for Parents & Teachers

- Orientation program was animated by our Principal on NEP & NCF for all the parents and teachers.
- Special programs like the personal SWOT analysis, Bloom's taxonomy, Learning objectives the highlights of orientation for our Teachers.
- Different topics of academic importance are continued under the topic "Study Smarter Not Harder" program for Higher grades students.

Communication

- To keep the parents involved in the daily running of the school activities and better communication, new Diaries have been printed and new Identity cards are issued.

Sports:
